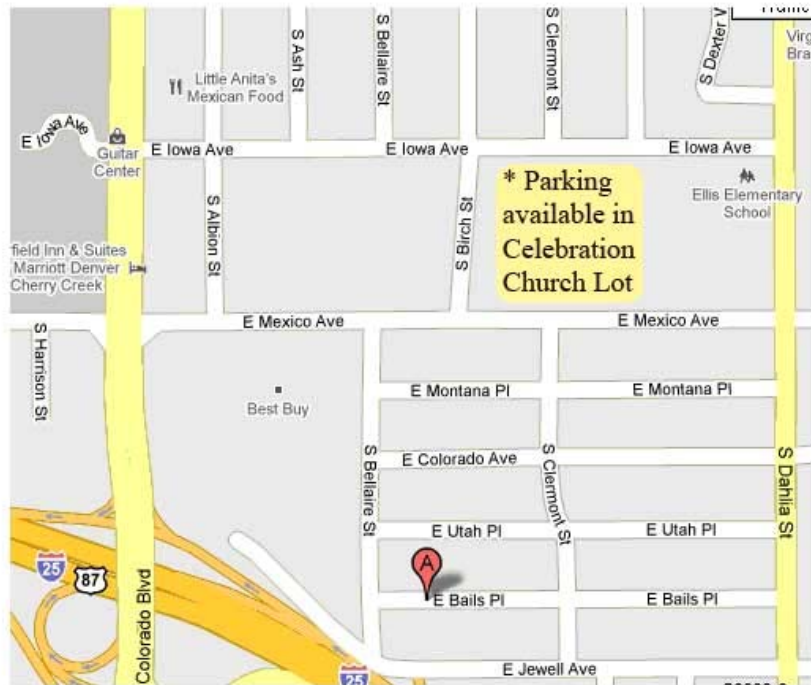




## 4350 E. Bails Place Denver, CO 80222



### **Driving Directions: (if driving NORTH on I-25 toward E. Evans exit)**

At the end of the Evans exit ramp off I-25, continue straight through the light as if you were getting back on I-25 to go north (this puts you on the I-25 Frontage Rd.) Take the first ramp on your right (about 200 yds. after you go thru the light at Evans) The Habitat site will be directly in front of you.

### **Driving Directions: (if driving SOUTH on I-25 toward E. Evans exit)**

At the end of the Evans exit ramp off I-25, turn left onto Evans  
Immediately after crossing over I-25, turn left at the light (as if you were getting back on I-25 to go north) This will put you on the I-25 Frontage Rd.  
Take the first ramp on your right (about 200 yds. after turning onto the Frontage Road)  
The Habitat site will be directly in front of you.

### **Parking:**

Parking is **not** available on Bails, Bellaire and Jewell due to heavily enforced 1 hour parking.  
Parking is available on Utah, Colorado and Montana EAST of Clermont (between Clermont and Dahlia).  
Parking is available at Celebration Community Church at the intersection of Iowa and Birch. If you choose this option, please note that it is a 10 minute walk to the site. We recommend that you bring everything you will need for the day with you in the morning, including your lunch.

- **If possible, please plan to be dropped off at the site or carpool with other volunteers.**
- **Please allow extra time for parking and walking to the site to ensure you will arrive prior to 9:00 am.**
- **Please be considerate of our neighbors and avoid parking in front of driveways and mailboxes.**

All volunteers are asked to arrive at the site a few minutes before 9:00 am and commit to working the full day until 4:30 pm. Please bring with you a sack lunch, water bottle, and sunscreen, and wear sturdy shoes. All necessary tools, hardhats, and safety glasses will be provided for your use on your workday. Volunteers under 16 years of age are not permitted.
