- ReStore Core Volunteer - Appliance Tester

Impact:

- Core Volunteers engage positively with the community of staff, volunteers, customers, and donors to bring awareness and understanding about Habitat for Humanity. All Core Volunteers serve in staff-like positions to enable the team to better serve the ReStore community.

Supervisor: ReStore staff

Major Responsibilities:

- Conduct limited testing to ensure the customer purchases a quality appliance
- Decide if an appliance will be sold, or recycled
- Clean and tag tested appliances
- Use proper radio etiquette
- Represent Habitat for Humanity in a positive and professional manner
- Be informed and up-to-date with current Habitat news, policies, and procedures

Time Commitment:

- Will work with volunteer team to determine schedule
- Core Volunteers commit to 15 hours or more per month

Qualifications:

- Understanding of safety procedures
- Basic electrical knowledge
- Troubleshooting ability

Training:

- Appliance Testers will be trained on what the ReStore does and does not take, what makes a good appliance, how to conduct limited testing, and how to fill out post-test stickers
- Appliance Testers will be willing to train new Core Volunteers interested in this position
