



Volunteer Position Description

Assignment Title: Door Painter - Core Volunteer

Supervisor and Department: Construction Warehouse Manager

Purpose or Overview: Paint doors in the Production Shop using an airless paint sprayer

Major Responsibilities:

- Prep the paint booth and work area
- Repair doors as needed (minor dents and scrapes from disassembly)
- Spray doors
- Move doors to the drying and staging area
- Clean up paint booth and sprayer

Time Commitment:

- One to four days per month
- Scheduled in advance, based on need

Qualifications:

- Comply with Habitat Metro Denver requirements to wear a respiratory mask
- Ability to lift and carry doors, bend, twist, and stand on cement floor for several hours at a time
- Previous experience using a paint sprayer is preferred but not required

Training: Volunteer will be trained to use and maintain our paint sprayer safely, utilizing all required personal protective equipment.

Service Location: Construction Warehouse, 520 Raritan Way, Denver, CO 80204

Impact:

- Saves valuable time by painting doors with a paint sprayer in a single day (painting doors takes much longer by hand on the construction site)
- Ensures that doors are given a quality finish with very little touch-up required
- Allows us to accelerate our construction schedule so families can move in sooner
