

Volunteer Position Description

Title: Core ReStore Volunteer

Supervisor and Department: ReStore Supervisors and Staff (ReStore Operations Department)

Purpose or Overview:

Core ReStore Volunteers make an ongoing commitment to one of the four Habitat Denver ReStores. Core Volunteers are trained in a chosen position to provide support across ReStore operations and help increase funding for Habitat Denver. Volunteers work alongside staff, future homeowners, and other volunteers.

Major Responsibilities:

- Perform tasks for a specific ReStore position for a half day or more (3.5 hours) weekly
- Model appropriate safety procedures
- Help staff engage daily volunteers when needed
- Sign in at the start of each shift
- Support and promote Habitat Denver's mission in our ReStores and our community

Time Commitment:

15 hours a month, flexible to allow for vacations and time off

Qualifications:

- No experience necessary!
- Patience, flexibility, and willingness to learn
- Ability to pass background check
- Ability to engage staff, volunteers, customers, and donors as needed
- Ability to stand, bend, kneel or sit for extended periods of time

Training:

ReStore Core Volunteers chose a particular position or area of service and will be trained by staff.

Denver, Littleton, Aurora, or Wheat Ridge

Impact:
