Assignment Title: ReStore Photographer Core Volunteer

Purpose or Overview: The ReStores are Habitat's Home Improvement Outlet stores, which generate revenue to build and preserve homes in partnership with low-income families in the Metro Denver area. The ReStores sell donated new and lightly used building materials, tools, and home goods such as furniture, appliances, and small wares. This position will help launch the online sales platform in all four ReStore locations.

Major Responsibilities:

- Find items of value in the ReStore to sell online
- Move and arrange items in an appealing manner
- Take high-quality photos of items
- Create description of items for listing by researching and taking measurements
- Work with the Online Support Core Volunteer to post items on e-commerce website
- Work closely with ReStore Project Manager and ReStore staff to keep inventory of photos current in database

Time Commitment: At least 4 hours/week

Qualifications:

- Experience in photography
- Own a high-quality camera, preferred
- Good eye for interior design
- Experience selling things on online marketplace, a plus
- Ability to work independently and with other ReStore staff and volunteers
- Data entry experience

Training: Will be provided on the job

Service Location: Initially located at the Denver ReStore, 70 Rio Grande Boulevard, Denver, with opportunity to support other stores in Littleton, Aurora and Wheat Ridge

Impact: Having online sales will help Habitat reach more customers, and increase revenue to support the mission of building homes, communities, and hope.
