



## Volunteer Position Description

**Assignment Title:** Core Construction Volunteer

**Supervisor and Department:** Construction Site Supervisors, Real Estate Development Department

### Purpose or Overview:

Core Volunteers are the 'core' that is essential to fulfilling our mission to build homes, communities and hope. Core Construction Volunteers make an ongoing commitment to our Construction programs. These include New Construction, Home Repair, Renovation, CAPABLE (aging in place) and the Production Shop.

### Major Responsibilities:

- Work alongside site supervisors and other volunteers on a variety of construction tasks
- Act as a leader, role model, and mentor for daily volunteers. This includes:
  - Being present and attentive for the daily volunteer orientation and safety talk
  - Demonstrating appropriate construction techniques and safety procedures
  - Leading small groups of daily volunteers with support from staff
- Log volunteer hours at the start of each build day to maintain accurate volunteer data

### Time Commitment:

- Attend a Volunteer Orientation within 30 days of expressing interest in the Core program
- Participate in 10 build days within the first 6 months of expressing interest in the Core program
- Dedicate 2 days per month to building upon official onboarding into the program

### Qualifications:

- No experience necessary! Every helping hand makes a difference.
- Willingness to complete all onboarding time commitments (see above)
- Ability to pass background check
- Ability to work outdoors in the elements for extended periods of time >4 hrs
- Ability to stand, bend, kneel or sit for extended periods of time >4hrs

**Training:** An introduction to Habitat for Humanity and our will be provided during Volunteer Orientation. Proper safety procedures will be shared at the start of each build during the daily safety talk. All other training will be provided on the job.

**Service Location:** Build sites throughout metro Denver

**Impact:** Construction Volunteers make a tangible difference with each and every day they help build and repair homes. Core Construction Volunteers are the leaders among these volunteers. Our affiliate truly could not do what we do without them.
